
BLOCK ASSEMBLY PROJECT USES PRECISE 1/4" SEAMS. TEST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE BY CUTTING (2) 2-1/2" X 5" RECTANGLES. STITCH THEM TOGETHER ALONG THE 5" LENGTH. AT THE MIDPOINT, MEASURE ACROSS THE UNIT. IT SHOULD BE EXACTLY 4-1/2' WIDE. IF NOT, ADJUST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE AND REPEAT.

## PAGODA BLOCK


1. Sew (1) A Template One, (1) F Template Two and (1) A Template Three together to create (1) **Center Unit**. Sew (1) A 3-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangle to each side of the **Center Unit** to complete **Section A**.








- **2.** Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) A 1-1/2" square. Place the square, right sides together, as one corner of (1) **B** 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim ¼" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal white solid corner triangle. Repeat with another **A** 1-1/2" square at the other corner of the **B** 1-1/2"  $\times$ 7-1/2" rectangle. Sew (1) **A** 1-1/2" x 4" rectangle to each side of the **AB** strip to complete **Section B**.
- **3.** Sew (1) **A** 2-1/2" x 5" rectangle to each side of (1) **F** 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangle to complete **Section C**.
- **4.** Repeat Step 2 using (2) **A** 1-1/2" squares, (1) **B** 1-1/2"  $\times$  10-1/2" rectangle and (2) A 1-1/2"  $\times$  2 ½" rectangles to complete Section D.
- **5.** Sew (1) **A** 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle to each side of (1) **F** 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangle to complete **Section E**.
- **6.** Repeat Step 2 using (2) **A** 1-1/2" squares, (1) **B** 1-1/2" x 13-1/2" rectangle and (2) **A** 1" x 1-1/2" rectangles to complete **Section F**.
- 7. Sew (1) **F** 2-1/2" x 4" rectangle to each side of (1) **A** 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle. Sew (1) **F** 1-1/2" x 11-1/2" rectangle to the top of the **AF** unit. Sew (1) **A** 2" x 3-1/2" rectangle to each side of the AF unit to complete Section G.
- **8.** Sew **Sections A-G** together, alternating each section with (1) A 1" x 14-1/2" rectangle to complete (1) Pagoda **Block A.** Square to 14-1/2" x 16-1/2".



- **9.** Repeat Steps 1-8 to make (5) **Pagoda Block A**'s total.
- **10.** Repeat Steps 1-8, using Fabric **A**, **C** and **G** rectangles to complete (4) Pagoda Blocks B.

## PIECED INNER BORDER

- **11.** Sew (1) **B** 1-1/2" x 2" rectangle to each side of (1) **A** 1-1/2" square. Sew (1) **B** 2" x 4-1/2" rectangle to the top and bottom of the **AB** unit. Square to 4-1/2" to make (1) **AB** block center.
- **12.** Sew (1) A 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle to each side of (1) **AB** block center. Sew (1) **A** 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle to the top and to the bottom of the **AB** block center. Square the block to 6-1/2" to complete (1) **AB Block**.



**13.** Repeat Steps 11-12 to make the following blocks: (8) AD; (8) AF; (8) AI; (6) AB; (4) AG; (4) AC; (2) AE; (2) AJ

BORDER ASSEMBLY MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE **OUR CUTTING SIZES.** 

## **QUILT CENTER ASSEMBLY:**

- **14.** Refer to the quilt layout to sew (5) **Pagoda Block A's**, (4) **Pagoda Block B's** and (12) **A** 2-1/2" x 16-1/2" rectangles and (4) A 2-1/2" x (50-1/2") sashing strips together to make the quilt center.
- **15.** Sew (1) **H** 1-1/2" x (56-1/2") border strip to each side of the guilt center. Sew (1) **H** 1-1/2" x (52-1/2") border strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt center.
- **16.** Sew (1) A 1-1/2" x (58-1/2") border strip to each side of the quilt center. Sew (1) A 1-1/2" x (54-1/2") border strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt center.
- **17. PIECED BORDER:** Sew (10) assorted border blocks together to make one side border. Repeat to make a second side border. Sew the borders to each side of the quilt center. Sew (11) blocks together to make top border. Repeat to make a bottom border. Sew the borders to the top and to the bottom of the quilt center.
- **18.** Sew (1) A 1-1/2" x (72-1/2") border strip to each side of the quilt. Sew (1) A 1-1/2" x (68-1/2") border strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt.
- **19.** Sew (1) **F** 3-1/2" x (74-1/2") border strip to each side of the quilt. Sew (1)  $\mathbf{F}$  3-1/2" x (74-1/2") border strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt.

**FINISHING** Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.
