
Block 8 - Dessert Breads

Block is 9.5" x 9.5" Finished size 9"x 9"

Cutting & Sewing

Light background Fabric

- Cut 8 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" for HST
- Cut 8 Squares 2" x 2"
- Cut 2 strips 2" x 3 1/2"

Medium Fabric - `

- Cut 4 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" for HST
- Cut 2 squares 2" x 2"
- Cut 2 strips 2" x 3 1/2"

Dark Fabric -

- Cut 4 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" for HST
- Cut 2 squares 2" x 2"

Directions

1) Using the 2 1/2" light and 2 1/2" medium squares make HSTs using method on the last page or use one of the other methods from my Triangle book

trim to 2" square Make 8 units



2) Using the 2 1/2" light and 2 1/2" dark squares make HSTs using method on the last page or use one of the other methods from my Triangle book

trim to 2" square Make 8 units



Directions

3) Following the diagram, sew 4 light/medium hst from page 1, 2 light 2" squares, 1 medium 2" square, and a 2" x 3 1/2" medium strip


Make 2

Measures 5" x 5"




4) Following the diagram, sew 4 light/dark hst from page 1, 2 light 2" squares, 1 dark 2" square, and a 2" x 3 1/2" light strip
Make 2

Measures 5" x 5"



5) Following the diagram, Sew the 4 units together Make 1

Measures 9 1/2" x 9 1/2"


IN the Quilt it is finished size 9" x 9"

16 blocks 24 strips 2" x 9.5" 9 squares 2" x 2"






Half Square Triangles Tutorial

NOTE- For other ways to make HST units, see my book "Pat Sloan's Teach Me to Sew Triangles"




Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2


- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a ¼" seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST





-Trim squares to size using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
