





Naterial Requirements:

- ½ yard each of 8 different fabrics for the stars (Fabric A Blue 1; Fabric B Orange 1; Fabric C Green 1; Fabric D Yellow 1; Fabric E Blue 2; Fabric F Orange 2; Fabric G Green 2; Fabric H Yellow 2)
- 3 ¼ yards background/border fabric
- ¾ yard binding fabric
- 5 yards backing fabric


- 1. Please read through all of the instructions.
- 2. All seam allowances are 1/4".
- 3. RST means right sides together.
- 4. WOF means width of fabric.
- 5. HST means half square triangle.

- From each ½ yard star fabric, cut one (1) 10" x WOF strip. Sub-cut into three (3) 10" squares and one (1) 9 ½" square.
- 2. From the background fabric:
 - a. Cut two (2) 18 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut into four (4) 18 1/2" squares.
 - b. Cut two (2) 9 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut into eight (8) 9 1/2" squares.
 - c. Cut two (2) 10" x WOF strips. Sub-cut into eight (8) 10" squares.
 - d. Cut eight (8) 4 1/2" x WOF strips for the borders.

Block Assembly:

Piecing Half Square Triangles:

Select a Fabric A and Fabric B 10" square. Place RST and mark a line across the diagonal. Sew ¼" on each side of the diagonal line (Fig. 1). Cut along the drawn line to create two HSTs (Fig. 2). Press the seams open and trim each HST to measure 9 ½" square (Fig. 3).



- 2. Repeat this process using the following pairs of 10" squares:
 - Fabrics A & C
 - Fabrics B & D
 - Fabrics C & D
 - Fabrics E & F
 - Fabrics E & G
 - Fabrics F & H
 - Fabrics G & H
- 3. Repeat the process again using one of each 10" star fabric square matched with a 10" background square.

Piecing the Blocks:

4. Using the block diagram table, piece together the appropriate HSTs and 9 ½" squares into blocks as shown, pressing seams open. *Note:* BKGD = Background fabric


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Block 8	C/A HST; A/B HST C/D HST; B/D HST	
Block 9	G/H HST; H/F HST E/G HST; E/F HST	
Block 10	F/BKGD HST; BKGD Sq. F Sq.; F/BKGD HST	
Block 11	D Sq.; D/BKGD HST D/BKGD HST; BKGD Sq.	
Block 12	BKGD/E HST; E Sq. BKGD Sq.; BKGD/E HST	

DEND POINT TOP Assembly:

- 1. Lay out the 18 ½" background squares and pieced blocks according to the Quilt Layout Diagram on page 5.
- 2. Sew the blocks into rows, pressing seams open.
- 3. Sew together rows 1 & 2 and then rows 3 & 4.
- 4. Sew the pieced rows together to complete the center of the quilt top.
- 5. Sew together two (2) 4 ½" x WOF strips end to end and trim down to create a side border that measures 4 ½" x 72 ½". Repeat to make a second side border.
- 6. Sew the side borders onto the quilt, pressing toward the border fabric.
- 7. Sew together two (2) 4 ½" x WOF strips end to end and trim down to create a top border that measures 4 ½" x 80 ½". Repeat to make a bottom border.
- 8. Sew the top and bottom borders onto the quilt, pressing toward the border fabric.

Quilt Layout Diagram



Finish the Quilt:

- 1. Piece your quilt backing from two equal size pieces by sewing them together along the longest edge.
- 2. Make a quilt sandwich with the quilt top, batting and backing and baste.
- 3. Machine or hand quilt as desired.
- 4. Bind using eight (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips of fabric stitched end to end.
