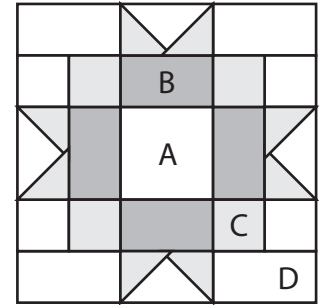
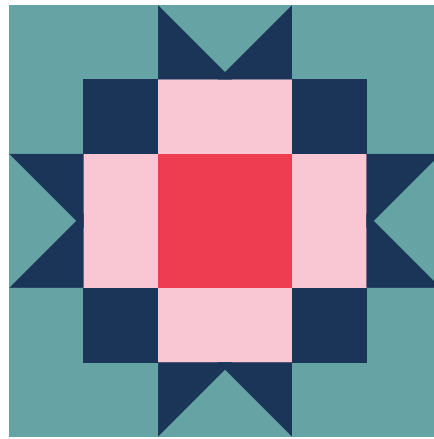


Maple Star Quilt Block



6 INCH BLOCK

Fabric A: (1) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

Fabric B: (4) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2"

Fabric C: (12) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2"

Fabric D: (8) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2"
(4) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2"

12 INCH BLOCK

Fabric A: (1) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"

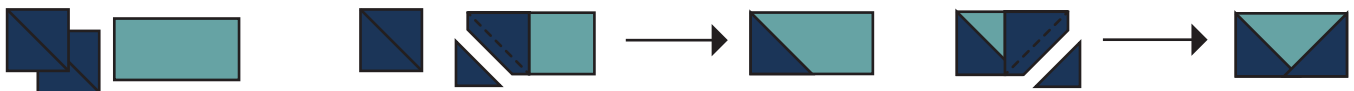
Fabric B: (4) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"

Fabric C: (12) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

Fabric D: (8) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"
(4) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

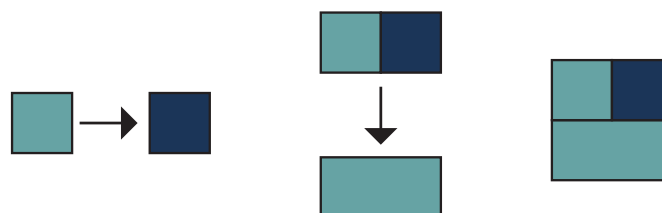
Make Flying Geese Units:

Mark the wrong side of fabric C (sky unit) along the diagonal. Sew fabric C to fabric D rectangle (goose unit) along the marked line with a scant seam. Trim, and press towards C. Repeat on the other side of D rectangle. Make (4) flying geese units.



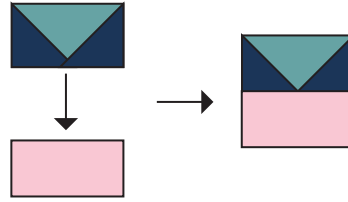
Make Corner Units:

Sew C square to D square, and press towards D. Sew D rectangle to the top of the unit, and press towards D.



Expand Flying Geese Units:

Sew flying geese unit to fabric B along sky unit side. Press towards B.



Assemble Block:

Sew corner units to geese units, and press towards corner units. Sew geese units to fabric A, and press towards A. Sew top and bottom units to center unit, and press away from center.
