


Block 7 – Beautiful Tunes

Cutting & Sewing

Light Fabric

- you can use multiple fabrics for A scrappy look

- Cut 1 squares 7" x 7" for HST (Half square Triangles)
- Cut 5 squares 2.5" x 2.5"
- Cut 2 rectangles 2.5" x 4.5"

Medium Fabric

- you can use multiple fabrics for A scrappy look

• Cut 1 squares 7" x 7" for HST (Half square Triangles)

- Cut 5 squares 2.5" x 2.5"
- Cut 2 rectangles 2.5" x 4.5"

Directions

1) Sew a light 7" square and a medium 7" Square using the HST method on last page.

trim to 6.5" square Make 2 units





2) Following the diagram sew 3 medium squares, 2 light squares, and 2 light rectangles Measures 6.5" x 6.5"


Make 1






3) Following the diagram sew 3 light squares, 2 medium squares, and 2 medium rectangles Measures 6.5" x 6.5"

Make 1



4) Following the diagram, sew the 2 HST units and 2 units from above, note positions Measures to 12.5" x 12.5"


Half Square Triangles Tutorial

NOTE- For other ways to make HST units, see my book "Pat Sloan's Teach Me to Sew Triangles"




Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares




Step 2

- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both
- Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST



Step 4

-Trim squares to size needed using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
